### Main Street Event in Salem Starts Businesses on Road to Energy Savings

Franklin Energy's New Hampshire team hosted a Main Street event June 10-11 in Salem, NH, in collaboration with the Liberty and Unitil NHSaves programs. The event provided businesses with no-cost energy assessments to identify energy-efficient improvements aimed at lowering utility bills. Over 20 assessments were completed, identifying lighting upgrades, weatherization opportunities, and HVAC improvements.

The event received strong local support. The town manager attended along with representatives from the offices of U.S. Rep. Maggie Goodlander, D-N.H., Sen. Jeanne Shaheen, D-N.H., and the Southern New Hampshire Chamber of Commerce. A diverse team of trade allies including AECOM, Oberon, RISE Engineering, LED Conversions, and NRM supported the event.
